
OUR COMMITMENT TO INCLUSION



At ChildrenConnect, each room is specifically designed around a theme and lays the foundation for related exhibits. Choose how and what you would like to sponsor.

ENTIRE ROOM

Sponsoring a room provides the greatest impact of shaping childhood development. Typically a <u>5-year agreement</u>, including the initial investment plus the annual exhibit fee.

Includes <u>name recognition of the room</u>, contribution to long term design influence, renovations, strategic plan, and program development. All details, including the name of the room can be altered to meet needs of the donor.

INDIVIDUAL EXHIBITS

Sponsor an individual exhibit that matches your passion. Typically a <u>3-year agreement</u>, including the initial investment plus the annual exhibit fee. Then we will meet to renew, expand investment, or enable another sponsor to participate.

The annual fee is intended to support upkeep, maintenance, and program staffing needs.

HEALTHCARE EXHIBIT Initial \$3,000 & \$500 Annually

In this exhibit, children will enter the role of a healthcare professional. Included with a white coat and all the medical supplies children need to take care of people or animals. This exhibit would include an exam table, x ray machine, stuffed animals and medical tools.




SPACE EXHIBIT

Initial \$6,000 & \$1000 Annually

Explore space! This exhibit will have a child size spaceship and dress up for kids to pretend. There will also be solar system displayed and educational content related to science, space and gravity for learning.

VISITING EXHIBIT

\$500 per Monthly Exhibit

Temporary exhibits not only create excitement and encourage repeat visits, they also allow the museum to honor certain holidays, heritages and learning. Examples include;

- Native American Heritage
- Industrial Revolution- Model T & Auto History
- Education Month: Based on an educational theme or historic event

STEM ROOM: Create & Explore cont.



PNEUMATIC TUBES

Initial \$3,000 & \$500 Annually

Air Maze- pneumatic tubes are systems that propel cylindrical containers through networks of tubes by compressed air or by partial vacuum.



LEGO STATION & TEST RAMP Initial \$3,000 & \$1000 Annually

Enter the world of building and creativity, children can build and create at their own pace at a large lego table. This station will also be home to our after school "Lego Club" for children ages 5-12.



MAGNET TABLE

Initial \$10,000 & \$2000 Annually

Create a sculpture using ferrous metal objects held together by magnetic force. Dive into the physics of magnetic force and repulsion between two objects.



PIXEL PEG WALL

Initial \$2,000 & \$1500 Annually

Explore light, color and patterns by inserting transparent colored rods into the light box. This is suitable for early childhood play areas, this activity encourages fine-motor skills and opportunities for social interaction.



Children can engage in creative play while developing fine and gross motor skills, exploring new foods, sorting and counting, and learning cooperation and social skills.



LITERACY CORNER Initial \$2500 & \$800 Annually

Create a tiny library with outdoor feel for children to participate in weekly story time and early literacy activities! Children will find soft spaces to listen to stories, read and create. A small dress up station will be available within this exhibit that allows children to bring stories to life. Drawing pads and writing utensils are available for illustration and writing workshops.

ROTATING TOY EXHIBIT

Initial \$2500 & \$1000 Annually

This exhibit provides the sponsor with the flexibility to provide different age-appropriate STEM toys for toddlers, ideally with an outdoor or nature theme. On a quarterly basis, different types of toys are donated and rotated based on a specific learning theme or season. The following toy exhibits could include but are not limited to:


- **Summer Fishing Experience** allow kids to practice fishing with magnetic fishing poles and a pretend pond
- Fall Garden- children can practice planting and picking vegetables in their pretend garden
- Music & Movement- instruments for play, ribbons for dancing, life size piano keys for jumping on



MAKERSPACE: Craft Room²

The MakerSpace is the heart of ChildrenConnect. It is where creativity comes alive with endless art and mixed media supplies. It's home base for drop-in crafts, workshops, camps, field trips and birthday parties. Platinum Play: Includes Capital Improvements SRON SORED

MAKERSPACE IMPROVEMENTS Initial \$10,000 & \$2,000 Annual

Improve the function and appearance of our most heavily used room with the following;

- Art sink station with new cabinetry, countertops, sink, faucet, drinking water dispenser, dishwasher and corresponding plumbing and electrical needs.
- **Floor repair** and refinishing to fix gaps
- Existing cabinetry alteration for larger floorspace, finished countertops and custom toe kicks
- **Paint** ceiling and walls. Potential custom mural
- Annual fee to cover maintenance and craft supplies

MUSEUM SPACES

Improve common spaces within the museum to create a great visitor experience.

WELCOME HALLWAY

Initial \$8,000 & \$1,000 Annual

Includes refinishing hardwood floors, paint (potential murals), signage, tribute to Male Academy, child gallery wall and ceiling decor. Annual fee to cover maintenance, marketing materials and front desk tech.

BATHROOMS

Initial \$5,000 & \$1,000 Annual

Includes vanities, mirrors, vents, paint, steam cleaning tile. Annual fee to cover maintenance and consumable bathroom supplies.

NEWNAN TRAIN EXHIBIT

Initial \$30,000 & \$3,000 Annual

All aboard a child-size train to climb on, play and pretend! This exhibit will be a community attraction and located next to the museum. It will be utilized by the general community, camps, educational transportation programs and holiday events. The exhibit will be accessible with sidewalks and ramps for strollers and wheelchairs to access the exhibit.



WATER EXHIBIT Initial \$6,000 & \$1,000 Annually

Gain a better understanding of energy, currents and sensory play! This water exhibit is appropriate for all ages and abilities, and can change based on the learning theme provided. The initial fee covers a proper water container for the exhibit, supplies and ways to protect the ground with proper drainage.

INCLUSIVE PLAY

\$3500 Total

Our goal is to be a fully accessible space not just physically, but also socially. Here is how could contribute to this cause;

Sensory Saturdays (\$1,200)

Sponsor monthly access for children with sensory disorders to enter the building an hour early to play and explore as requested. This would allow for drop in fees to be free for up to 10 children on Sensory Saturdays for one year.

Accessibility (\$1,500)

Sponsor construction projects to ensure our space is handicap accessible with a ramp at the front entrance of the building.

Inclusion Library (\$800)

Sponsor accessibility and calming tools to help promote inclusion among autistic visitors, such as headphones, fidget toys, weighted blankets, and communication cards.
